# PRIVACY POLICY

## 1. Data of Responsible Organization

In compliance with the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation 679/2016, the Organic Law 15/1999, of Protection of Personal Data (hereinafter "LOPD"), and Law 34/2002 of July 11, of Services of the Information Society and Electronic Commerce, and remaining regulations of application, we inform you that the person in charge of the personal data received via the Website **livit.design**, is as follows:

The Company is committed to keep the information you provide us under strictest confidentiality avoiding unauthorized access, manipulation of information, loss, destruction or theft of information. For this, we will apply the security measures established by the applicable regulations and all those that our resources and modern technology allow us. Keep in mind that in many cases, it is essential that you provide the information we request to be able to enjoy the benefits of our website.

## 2. Purpose

The purpose of this Privacy Policy is to inform you about how we treat your Personal Data. If you do not agree with the terms contained in this Policy and do not accept them in your registration process, you cannot continue with the use and access to the website. If you have any questions regarding the content, you can contact us at the email address indicated in the header.

## 3. Scope of the Application

The current policy applies to all our website visitors regardless of location or time of the visit.

## 4. Data that we request from our users

On the website we may request basic information through our contact form, such as your full name, address, telephone, as well as free text space to send questions, complaints or suggestions. We may also manage data obtained through cookies, which can be reviewed in more detail under our Cookie Policy.

## 5. Purpose of data treatment

The purposes with which we request or automatically collect the information are the following::

- I. Properly manage the website and answer your questions or requests
- II. Manage your complaints or recommendations
- III. Manage CVs received from the interested parties
- IV. Ensure our user's safety
- V. Check in certain cases the veracity of your information
- VI. Perform marketing actions; send promotional messages, and depending on your communication preferences, advise on events, offers and activities that may interest you.



## 6. Subcontracting

The user expressly authorizes the company to contract services in whole or in part with third parties whose intervention it deems appropriate for the proper development of the services. In this case, the company is obliged to sign a contract with the subcontracted third party stipulating the obligations that it must fulfil in relation to the protection of personal data. In particular it will be required to comply with the same protection of personal data obligations. Data to which the company has committed with its users, as well as sufficient guarantees of application of appropriate technical and organizational measures so that the treatment is in accordance with the applicable regulations.

The Company will be diligent in the selection of suppliers through the application of regulatory compliance verification mechanisms, with the objective of minimizing any risk that may affect the security of the information to which the third party may access.

## 7. Users' Rights

The current regulations contain a series of fundamental rights in favor of the people whose data are treated. This section provides information on how to exercise the rights that assist you as a user, with respect to your personal data. All the rights mentioned below may be exercised by sending your request by email to the address: info@livit.design, accompanied by a copy of your formal identity document. Please note that we may request additional information to verify your identity before proceeding with your request.

### I. Right of access:

The right of access allows the user to access freely any personal data held by the company.

You may ask us to tell you what information we hold about you.

### II. Right of amendment:

This right is characterized because it allows correction of errors, modifying the data proven to be inaccurate or incomplete and guaranteeing the certainty of the information being treated. You must inform us of any changes to your data and you are responsible for updating your information.

### III. Right to cancel/delete/to be forgotten:

The right of suppression allows the deletion of data that proves to be inadequate or excessive, without prejudice to the duty to block, included in the LOPD.

### IV. Right of Opposition:

The right of opposition is the right of the user to not carry out the processing of their personal data or to cease it for certain purposes. You can oppose the processing of your data indicating the specific purposes object of opposition.

### V. Right of Portability:

The right of portability will allow you to request a copy in a structured, commonly used and mechanical reading of your personal data.



## 8. Security Measures

In the treatment of your personal information we apply adequate security measures according to the data type and the advances of the technology, our physical and legal media. Our goal is to prevent unauthorized third party access, theft, loss or disclosure of your information. However, the Internet is not a totally secure environment, so even if we apply all the possible security measures, the risk of incident with respect to the information will never disappear completely, for this reason we ask that if you detect any incident or have indications that your information may be at risk, contact us so we can investigate and offer solutions.

## 9. Modifications to the Privacy Policy

The company may in the future modify this Privacy Policy. In case of modification, in addition to publishing the updated version, we will inform you about such modification visible on the website. You must read these modifications before continuing to use the web.

## 10. Applicable law and jurisdiction

This Policy, as well as the use of the website, is governed by Spanish legislation. Any dispute will be resolved before the courts corresponding to the user's address.

In the event that any stipulation is unenforceable or void by virtue of the applicable legislation or as a consequence of a judicial or administrative decision, such unenforceability or nullity will not render this Policy unenforceable or void as a whole. In such cases, the Company will proceed to modify or replace said stipulation with another that is valid and enforceable and that, as far as possible, achieve the objective and claim reflected in the original stipulation.
